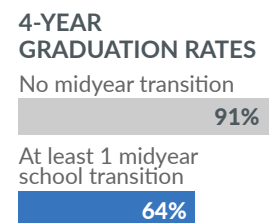


# Midyear School Transitions & 4-Year Graduation for the Oregon High School Class of 2020

## Focus: Cross-Program Participation

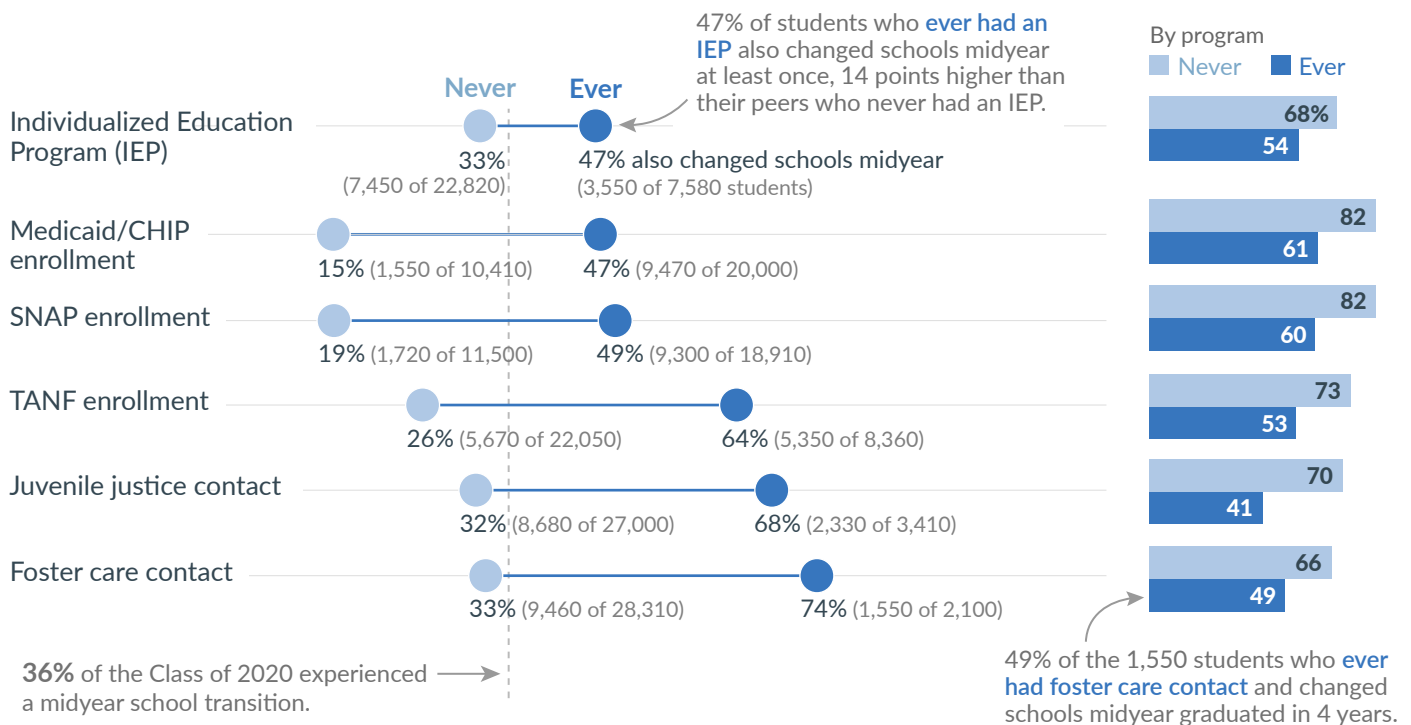
Oregon has progress to make in improving educational outcomes for students who change schools midyear. In the Oregon Class of 2020, more than 11,000 students ever changed schools midyear; their graduation rate of 64% was nearly 30 points lower than their peers without a midyear transition (91%). Many other public programs interact with these students, showcasing opportunities to provide support or to intervene earlier.

**36%** of students in the Class of 2020 ever changed schools midyear.
